National Drug Code (NDC)

CMS-1500

All provider-administered drugs (J codes) include:

- NDC
- Correct quantity and unit
- All data elements, including HCPCS/CPT® code

CMS-1450

- NDC
- Correct quantity and unit for J-codes for outpatient hospital claims
- All data elements, including HCPCS/CPT® code

Data Elements

1. NDC Qualifier	N4
2. NDC Number	11 – digit number
3. NDC Quantity Qualifier	F2 – International Unit GR – Gram ML – Milliliter UN – Unit
4. NDC Quantity	Numeric value
5. NDC Unit Price	(ANSI-837 only)

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Provider appeal

- ✓ Toll-free fax number: 1-888-357-1916
- ✓ Used to fax standard appeals for denied services
- ✓ Faxed standard-appeal documentation must include:
 - 1. Principal reason for upholding the noncertification determination
 - 2. Detailed clinical rationale
 - 3. Pertinent medical records for the specific case being appealed
