Re: Zoloft[®] and sertraline PDL Update

Effective August 24, 2006, brand name Zoloft[®] will become preferred on the TennCare PDL and the new generic formulation of Zoloft[®], sertraline, will become non-preferred. With this change, brand name Zoloft[®] will be listed as preferred on the PDL and count as a generic medication towards the prescription limit and for co-pays. Sertraline will count as a brand medication towards the prescription limit and for co-pays.
